I. Statistics of number of people registered (up to 30th June 2017)

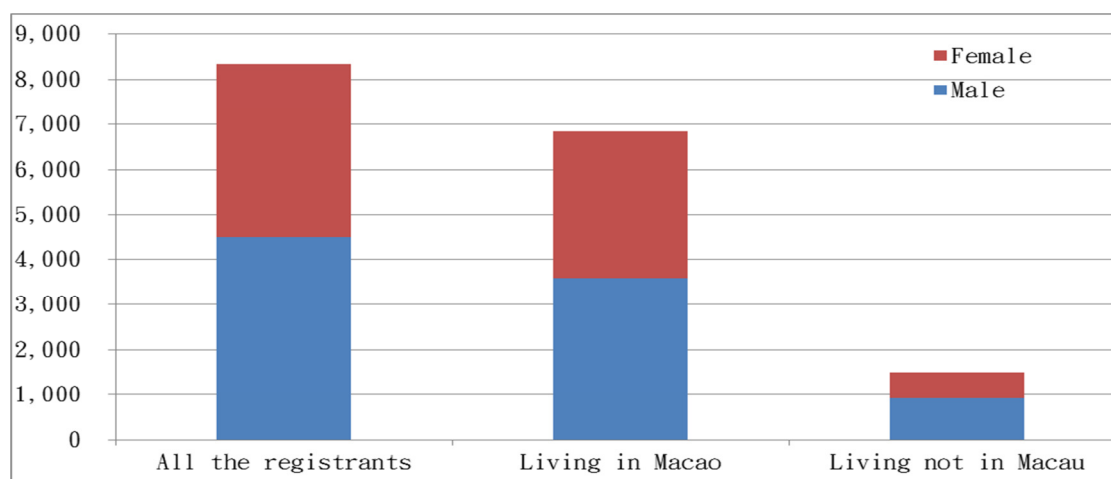
1.1 Number of registrants by current places of residence and gender

A total of 8,333 people were registered in the database of the Talents Information Registration, of whom 4,507 were male and 3,826 were female, respectively at a proportion of 54.09% and 45.91%. Of all those registrants, 6,841 people lived in Macao, accounting for 82.10% of the total. (See the table below).

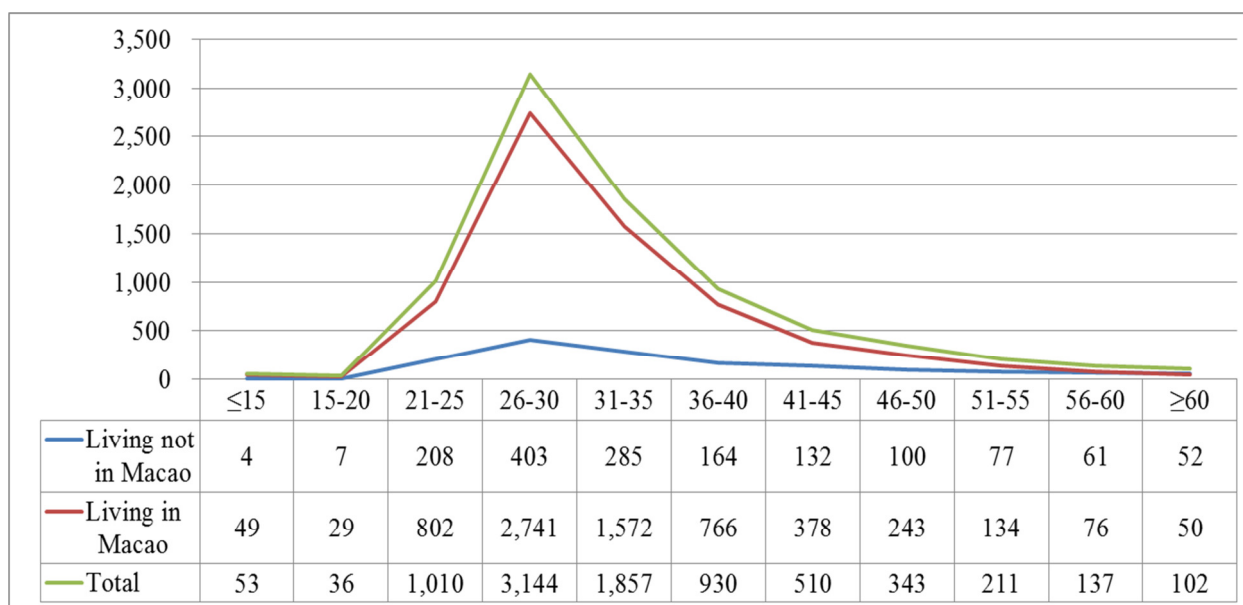
Chart I: Distribution of registrants by gender and place of residence

1.3 Distribution of current place of residence of the registrant

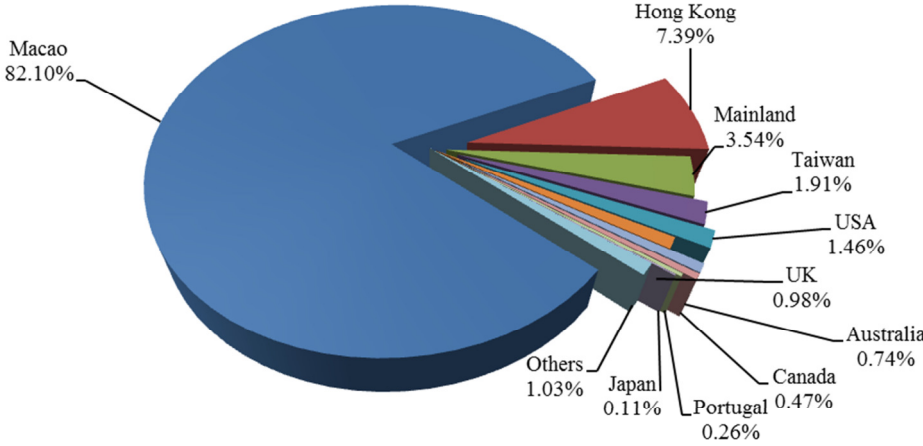
Most of the registrants, or say a number of 6,841 registrants, lived in Macao, and the first 4 categories of registrants lived in Macao, Hong Kong, Mainland China and Taiwan, totaling 7,911 persons, accounting for 94.94% of the total.

II. Work experience statistics

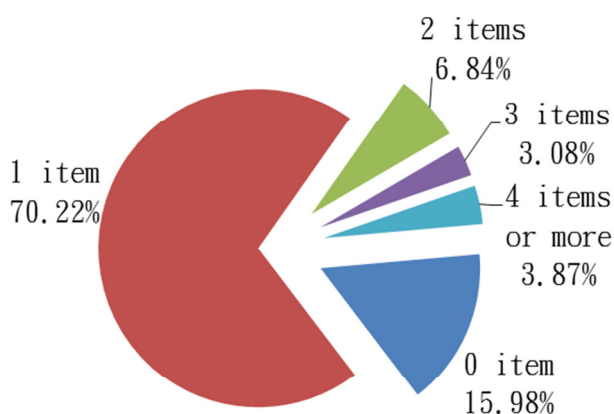
In terms of work experience, of the 6,841 registrants in Macao, 5,748 filled in their work experience, accounting for 84.02% of the total. Of the 1,492 registrants living not in Macao, 1,193 filled in their work experience, accounting for 79.96%.

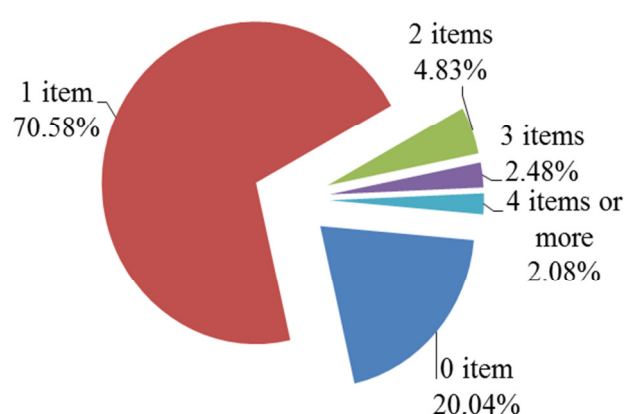

Work experience of registrants living not in Macao



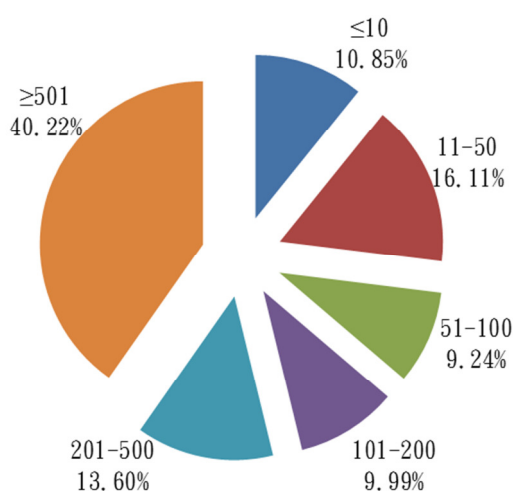
2.2 Distribution of sizes of companies in which the registrants worked

A total of 9,031 items of work experience were registered. Of the 7,579 registrants who lived in Macao, 3,048 people were employed by companies that hired more than 500 employees each, accounting for 40.22% of the registrants living in Macao. Companies with other sizes in which the registrants were hired had similar proportion of number of items, accounting for 9.24% to 16.11%, quite close to each other. There were 1,452 items for registrants who lived not in Macao. There were 710 items for registrants serving in companies that hired over 500 employees, accounting for 48.90%, being the highest proportion.

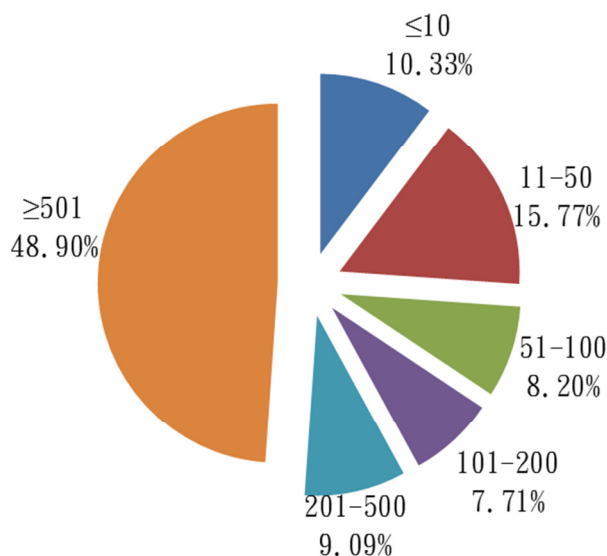
Chart V: Company size in which registrants living in Macao worked

Of the 5,748 registrants who lived in Macao and filled in their work experience, the first three industries they engaged in were gambling industry, education, public administration and social security affairs services, totally accounting for 34.01%.

Of the registrants living in Macao and living not in Macao, those who have a bachelor's and master's degree are in the first two places, holding an absolute proportion. Those who have a bachelor's or master's degree, sorted as living in Macao or living not in Macau, accounted for 81.33% and 77.18% respectively.

VI. License statistics

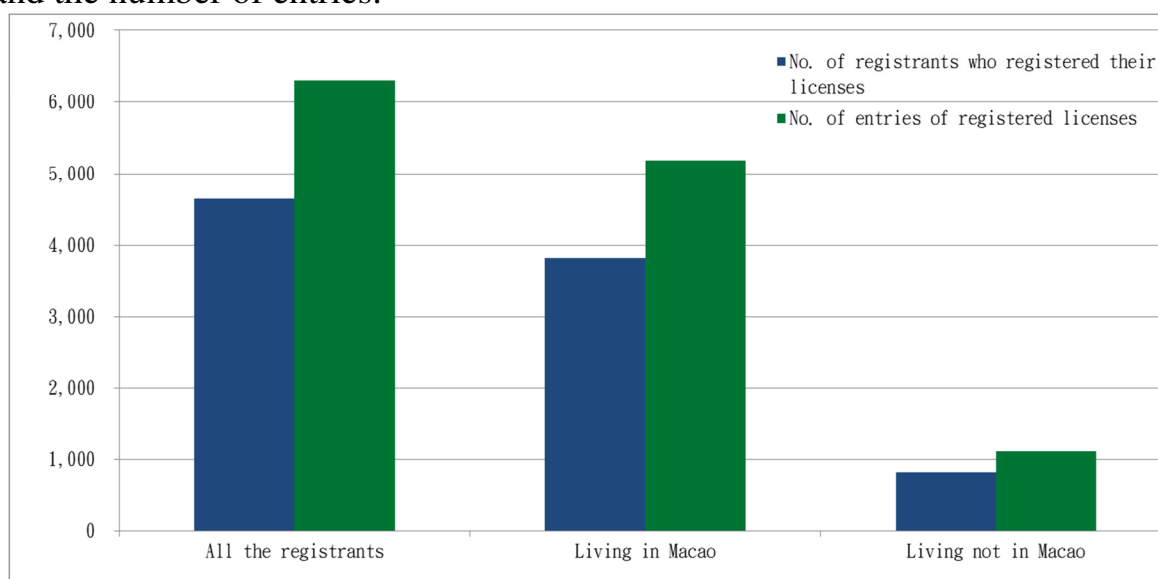
4.1 License filling-in status:

A number of 4,645 registrants filled in their license information, accounting for 55.74% of the total. The registration rates of registrants living in Macao and registrants living not in Macao were similar, being 55.80% and 55.50% respectively. The average numbers of entries were also very close to each other.

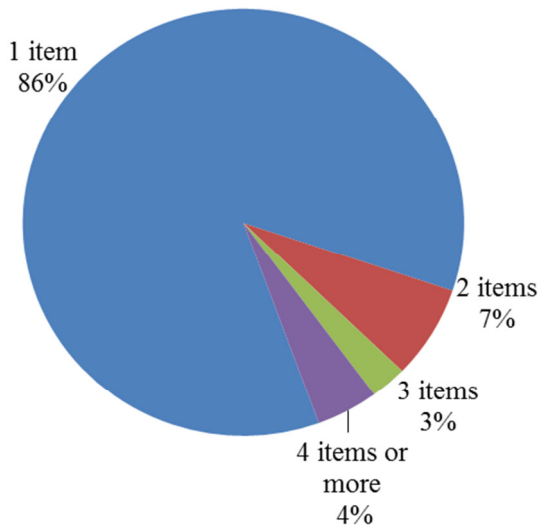
